The SRI award is a summer student award open to all McGill undergraduate students interested in pursuing research in any field or department at any institution*. Recipients of the award will receive **\$1000 CAD** to support their summer research endeavors. We encourage this award to be supplemented by PIs.

Our award is not merit-based and strives to provide equal footing for all students who are interested in pursuing research. We recognize that a competitive GPA is not indicative of research capability, work-ethic, and/or dedication to discovery and academia. As such, the award will not take into consideration GPA and/or prior research experience. Students of all backgrounds and education levels are encouraged to apply.

Applications will be open from **FEBRUARY 26** to **MARCH 26** at **11:59PM EST**.

Award results will be available mid-April, and disbursement will be made on **May 1st**
